As mathematicians, we will:

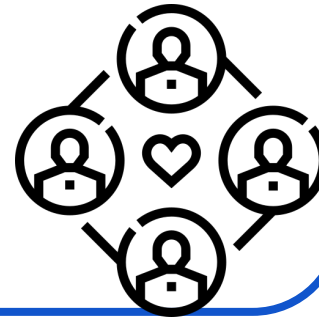
- Know our number bonds to 10

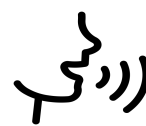
