It doesn't matter which rehearsal you attend or if you attend at different times each week. If you are not sure if singing in choir is for you, please come to a taster session on Wednesday 30 March (16.00 - 17.00 and 17.00 - 18.00). We would love you to be there!

There will also be an art club for pupils in KS2 in which they will be creating the props and scenery for the show. This will run on Wednesday's after school, more details and how to sign your child/ren will follow shortly.

This is going to be an incredible experience for our pupils to tell their family story - please send in your stories and recollections. It's time to reminisce!
