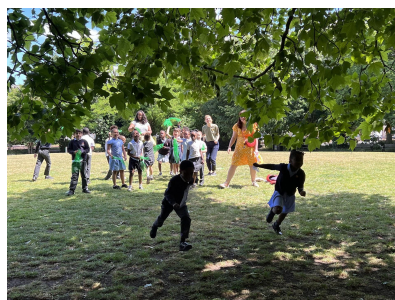
Hispanic Week
