News from our classes: What has been the most memorable learning this week?

Year 1:

We have worked really hard during our assessments this week. In geography we have been looking at oceans and we have learnt why they are so important and why we need to keep them clean! We are also starting our construction of our rocket ships using recycled materials.

Year 2:

This week in RE, we learnt about different types of crosses and studied their different meanings. We looked at the Egyptian ankh, the Jerusalem cross and the Ethiopian cross. We even designed our own version of the cross with its own spiritual meaning.

Mr Selvin's PE:

Year 3 students have been demonstrating their skills in football during their PE lessons. They have now transferred this learning to the playground where both boys and girls are enjoying playing football together during playtime.

Year 3:

In geography this week, we have been looking at earthquakes, volcanoes and tsunamis. We built different structures and tested which were 'natural disaster-proof'. In writing, we've been writing a newspaper report about a famous historical event!

Year 4:

Year four have had a busy assessment week. In between assessments the children have been looking at electricity. Exploring static charge and making their own circuits.

We also had a visit from Father David to answer questions about the holy communion

Year 6:

Year 6 wrote and published beautiful poems about Spring! They took a copy home to share and they have even been entered into a national poetry competition!
