News from our classes: What has been the most memorable learning this week?

EYFS:

We have been learning about the foods of India this week and using words to describe what we can feel and smell. We have also been discussing the human life cycle and discussing what changes occur as we grow up.

Year 1:

Year 1 had a very exciting week. We visited the Florence Nightingale museum where we met Florence herself. She showed us artefacts from her life 200 years ago and we learnt about how important her work was to health care.

Year 2:

We have had a really focused week. We have been learning about newspaper reports and we performed some ourselves! In maths we have started to learn about multiplication and division and in science we have been looking at the inside of a seed.

Year 3:

It has been a very busy assessment week, with Year 3 really showcasing their amazing learning! We have also spent some time in RE delving into Jesus' 'I Am' statements and thinking about what Jesus meant when he used them.

Year 4:

Year Four have been working through their reading, spag and maths assessments. The children are very excited for their trip to Hackney Empire on Tuesday 11th for Apollo Music.

Year 5:

In music this week, we began our musical production for the story Holes. We learnt a news song, actions and dance moves to tell part of the story.

Year 6:

This week the class has started a project that will help them in their transition to secondary school. The class has been carrying our research into their secondary school and will be adding what they have found out from their Year 7 transition day. We will continue to explore questions that we have about next year together as a class.

What happens when I become an adult or what happens when my responsibilities get ahead of me?


What happens when I start university or when I realise I have the privilege to choose?
