As artists & designers, we will:

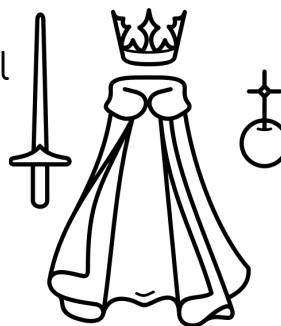
- Learn about constructing fairground rides.
