- Review and revise a range of strategies for arithmetic.

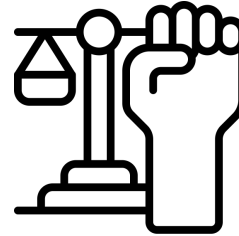
As artists & designers, we will:
